FAILURE TO FOLLOW THE RULES BELOW WILL LEAD TO DISQUALIFICATION

Boundaries:

The northern fishing boundary is the northern breakwater of Swansea channel. The southern fishing boundary is Sydney Harbour South Head. "Outside" fishing is defined as fishing east of a line between the headlands of the waterways within the boundaries. "Inside" fishing is defined as fishing upstream of a line between the headlands of the waterways within the boundaries.

Lines Down: 6:00 p.m. Friday.

Weigh-in:

All fish must be in the designated weigh-in area by 3:00 p.m. Sunday.

All fish must be gilled, gutted and not mutilated.

Any fish not specifically listed above are not considered weighable fish and will be awarded no points.

Each competitor's catch must be in separate containers (Separate plastic bags in one esky acceptable).
